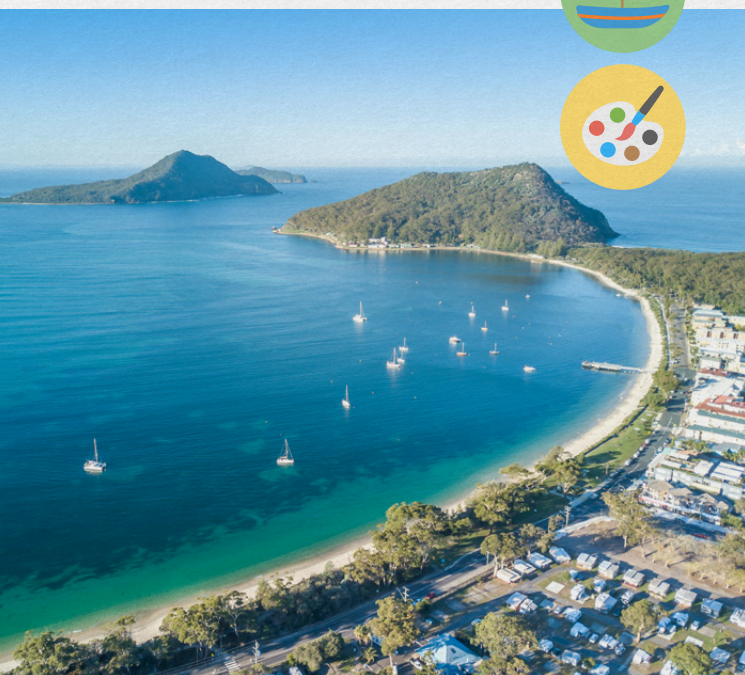


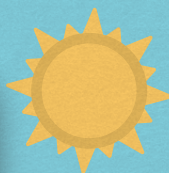

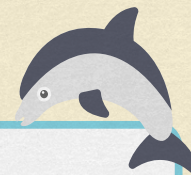

- 1** Walk out onto Shoal Bay Jetty and find the **CoastSnap** sign. The cradle above the sign says "Share a snap for" what?

- 2** Return to the path and find the large blue **information** sign. Which marine plants are the only flowering plants that grow underwater?

- 3** Keep walking along the path towards **Tomaree Headland** (the water will be on your left) and look for the large pink rock boulder with a plaque on it. This 1984 monument is in memory of "**Gelignite**" **Jack Murray**, a noted Australian car rally driver who holidayed regularly in Shoal Bay. The plaque mentions his and sportsmanship.

- 4** Continue along the path until you see the **Boating Safety Information** board. On the back of this sign, you'll see a large detailed map. The title of this map is the **Port Stephens-Great Lakes...**

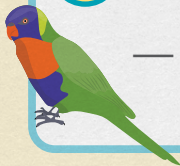
- 5** Continue along to the **Shoal Bay Art Trail** (hint: look down!). This is a series of hand-painted artworks inspired by the unique flora and fauna of Port Stephens. **Tip: for a 3D effect, stand in the footprints and look at the artworks through your phone camera.** Find the first artwork in the trail. What is the artist's first name?

- 6** Keep walking until you see the next artwork. What bird is perched next to the gymea lily?
